VINIFICATION

Type of vats : 50% stainless-steel and 50% concrete, all temperature controlled

Ageing : 16 to 18 months, one third in French oak barrels (50% of new) and two thirds in vats.

Average production : 140 000 bottles

Round, juicy and appealing, Château Bel-Air is both a very well-balanced and profound wine that expresses the sophistication and the finesse of its terroir. Powerful, rich and dense, it also has a great ageing potential.
